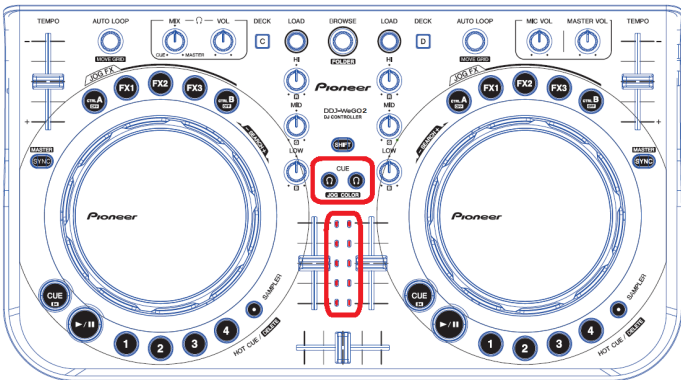

Updating Procedures

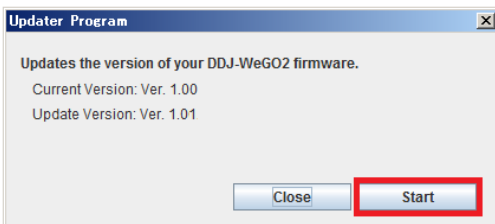
Note: Turn the power off and disconnect all the cables from the unit. Then, close all the applications on your computer before running this updating procedure.

- 1) Connect your computer to DDJ-WeGO2 via the USB cable included with the product.
- 2) Turn on the power of DDJ-WeGO2 while pressing the two [HEARDPHONE CUE] buttons (See the figure below) and ensure the Level meter LEDs (Figure below) flash before releasing your finger from the [HEARDPHONE CUE] buttons.



- 3) When the update file for DDJ-WeGO2 (DDJ-WeGO2_Vxxx.jar) is activated, the following dialogue is displayed. Click the [Start] button.

— Approximately 2 minute is required for updating.



- 4) When the firmware update process is complete, click the [OK] button.

Note: Please note that if you fail to update, turn on the power of DDJ-WeGO2 again and start from Step 2) of the above Updating Procedures.

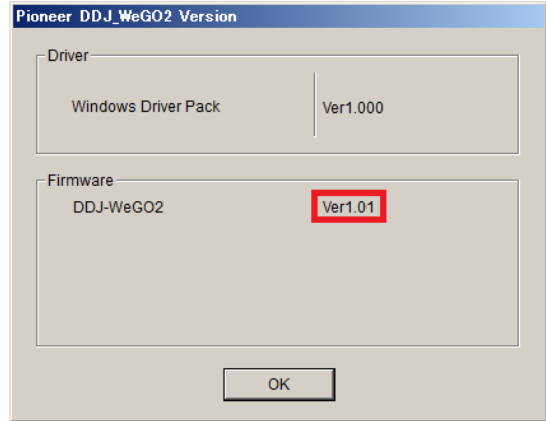
How to check the Firmware Version

For Windows

— ASIO driver exclusively for DDJ-WeGO2 is required to be

Installed to your computer.

From the [Start menu], Run [All Programs] → [Pioneer] → [DDJ-WeGO2] → [DDJ_WeGO2 Version Display Utility].
— Click [DDJ_WeGO2 Version Display Utility] tile on the Start Screen for Windows 8.

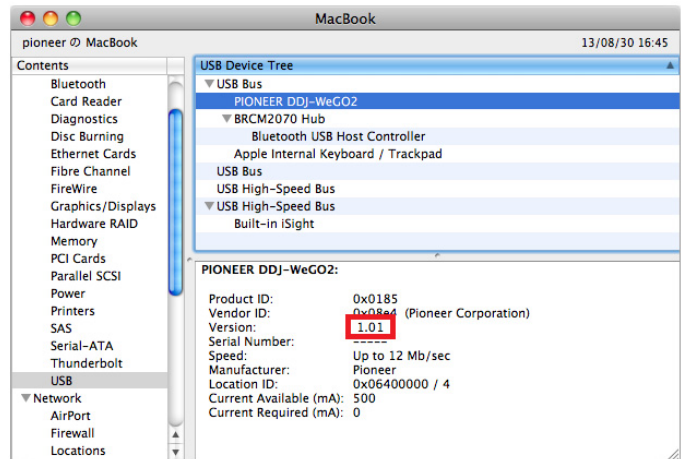


For Mac OS X

Open the Apple menu while pressing the option key, then select [System Profiler] or [System Information.]



Select the [USB] from the [Hardware] to display the name of the controller. Select the controller to display the firmware version.
