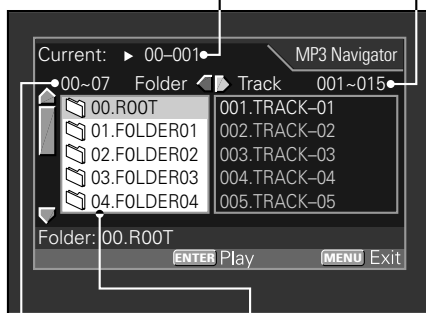

Added or Expanded Functions

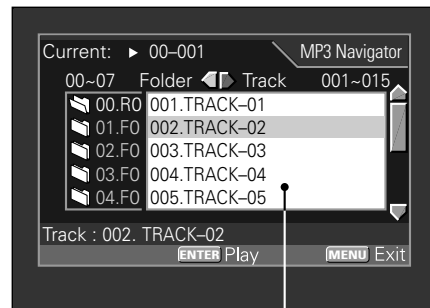
- **The ability to play CD-R/RW discs recorded in MP3 format has been added. Also, MP3 text information can be confirmed via the preview monitor display.**

Displays folder number together with folder name, or “ROOT”.
If folder name is recorded in a code other than English alphanumeric, a numbering series beginning with **“F_001”** will be displayed instead.

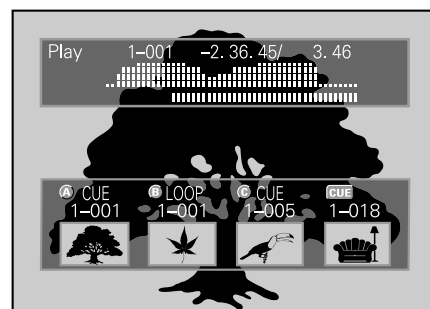
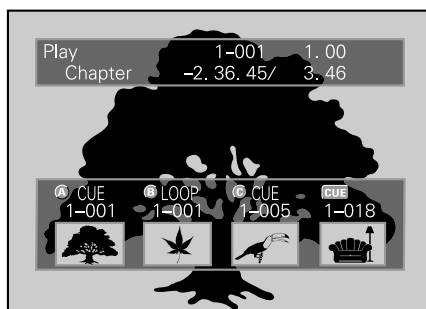


Track number and ID3 tag title

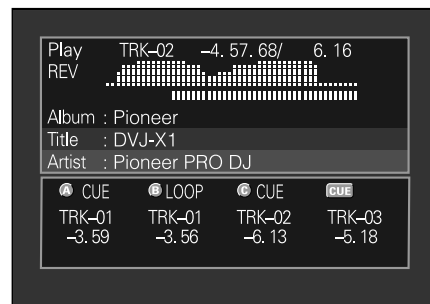
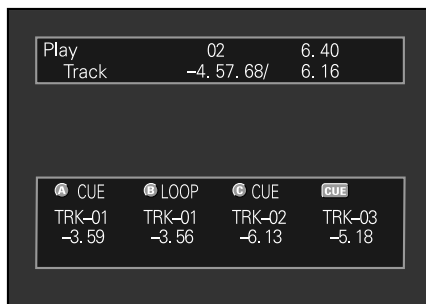
If no alphanumeric ID3 tag is recorded, the file name will be displayed. If ID3 tag and file name are not recorded as English alphanumeric, a series number beginning with **“T_001”** will be displayed.

- **One-track loop function has been added.** When the EMERGENCY LOOP button is held depressed for 1 second or more, the current chapter or track is played back as a loop.
- In addition to CDs, **DJ operation with DVDs also now allows digital audio output.**
- **Preview monitor image now adds the playing address and WAVE display.**

Improved Ease of Operation

- **About hot cue A/B/C recall when disc is inserted;** in earlier versions, recall of B and C hot cue points could not be performed until the A hot cue point recall was completed, but it is now possible to recall hot cue points B or C even before completing A hot cue point recall; **in other words, continuous recall scheduling is now possible.**
- In earlier versions, when a disc was played to its end, the player simply stopped; this function has been improved so that the player now enters the pause (standby) mode at the end of disc playback. As a result, **it is now possible to transition quickly from disc end to hot cue or back cue operations.**
- **The cue point navigation menu display can now be turned off by pressing the DISPLAY button if desired,** not only by the previous CUE/CALL LOOP button.

Improvement of Restricted Items/Functional Improvements

- **Data for the WAVE display** was previously read simultaneous **with CD playback** (real time read), but **read-ahead capability has now been added.**

Program Update Procedures

- 1. Confirm that unit power is OFF and no disc is loaded. In this condition, hold the REC MODE and RELOOP/EXIT buttons depressed simultaneously, and turn power ON.**
- 2. Release your fingers from the REC MODE and RELOOP/EXIT buttons when the “NO-DISC” message appears in the display.**
- 3. Insert the supplied program update disc.**
 - The display will show the “**DOWNLOAD-MAIN**” scrolling menu.
 - Do not turn power OFF while the update process is continuing.
 - The update process will be completed in about 3 minutes.
 - When the update is finished, the “**COMPLETE**” message will appear and the program update disc will be ejected.
- 4. Remove the program update disc and turn power OFF.**

This completes the update procedure.

* To confirm the DVJ-X1 system version:

- 1. Turn power ON.**
- 2. Hold the MASTER TEMPO button depressed for 10 seconds.**
 - The system version will be displayed on the main unit’s display panel and on the preview monitor connected to the PREVIEW output connector.
 - To return the DVJ-X1 to normal operation, turn the power OFF and then ON again.
